Hello, friends and fellow witches. This week, I had the pleasure of sitting down and chatting with an upcoming instructor for next trimester, Brother Zosimos.

Here's the first insider information: Brother Zosimos will be teaching at least two classes- "Greek Language For Religious Use" and "Hellenic Olympian Cult Practice." Indulge in the juicy 411 below.

Lybera (LD): First thing's first, what drew you to RAMA? Brother Zosimos (BZ): Someone [recommended] it to me! I run another Hellenic religion group on Discord where we do streamed religious services and educational activities, so I had been involved with teaching HelPol stuff already for several months. Someone who is in that group found RAMA, and [recommended] me to them. I received a message offer, researched the school, and really was just so impressed with it. So, I applied, took up the offer, and [I] have not regretted it since! I'm very excited and thrilled to have this opportunity, and I'm very grateful for it.

LD: So, do you personally practice HelPol? And if so, when and why did you get into that?

BZ: I do! I have been practicing Hellenism for over 8 years actually. I got into it at a really young age, because I come from a Greek family and I wanted to learn more about the faith and was already in love with the myths. So connecting to this religion was very important to me for those cultural reasons, and the longer I practice it, the more at home I feel with it. I'm very lucky to be able to share this with others and help them get involved with it too! It's a strong passion of mine.

LD: That's amazing and warming to hear. I was actually just about to ask if you were from a Greek family, but it seems you read my mind. Now, I am aware that you are teaching both Greek Language For Religious Use and Hellenic Olympian Cult Practice. Can you give us an idea or a little teaser about those courses? Please feel free to say as much or as little as you'd like

BZ: For Hellenic Olympian Cult Practice, I really try to emphasize that this religion (at least, the modern revival of it) is so young and new that it really demands a lot of new worshippers. There is so much that goes into the process of "converting" and helping with revival efforts, so encouraging students to do their own research and use their abilities to learn on their own is super important! The class involves a ton of research,

and multiple projects! Students will really get the chance to implement the religion into their daily lives and discover how they feel about it, if it is right for them, and discover their own opinions on various issues that revival efforts are dealing with today.

For Greek Language For Religious Use, the class should be super fun and engaging for people who are serious about getting a head start in learning Greek. It is a Modern Greek class, not Ancient, but students will get pretty far in the language in a short period of time if they stay on top of their work. I'm currently around halfway through the course in making my lesson plans, and I was actually recently reflecting on how far they can get! By the end of it, students will be able to compose their own hymns and prayers totally in Modern Greek. Students can do creative projects, talk to their classmates, learn new words on their own, and there is a huge opportunity for extra credit should students choose to take up that offer. My goal is to immerse them in not only the language, but also the culture. We'll do a lot with Modern Greek music too!

I must admit that both classes are pretty demanding - I upload lessons twice a week, and there [are] a good amount of assignments. But for students who put in the effort and want to involve themselves in it, they will truly surprise themselves by how much they learn. I'm very excited to see how well they do.

LD: ευχαριστώ! Thank you for all that. I am definitely excited to hear about these courses, and I know so many others who will be eager to sign up. Those sound amazing. Alright, alright. Last question: Is there anything else that you want RAMA students to know about you?

BZ: Teaching has always been a passion of mine, and I'm honestly just thrilled to be able to share this with them. While there [are] a lot of assignments and demanding work, the goal of the classes is to express yourself and grow in your faith and abilities, not to intimidate or cause stress!!! I'm here to help students for their very first introduction to a new language and wonderful faith!


And there you have it, folks. Is anyone else extremely excited?
